Unlike most globe-trotters

who return weighed down with mementos, Jiun Ho stows his travel keepsakes in his memory and imagination. With the Jiun Ho Collection V. the designer makes tangible the influences he's encountered in Asia, Africa, Europe, and North and South America. The Ica shelving unit in flat-sawn oak owes its origins to the work of Dutchman Piet Mondriannote the brightly lacquered storage boxes-as well as stonework found in Peru's Sacred Valley of the Incas, realized in the cast-bronze shelf supports. The same references shaped Pisac, a suite of cabinets with asymmetrical drawer and door fronts, some also highlighted with colorful lacquers. The Peruvian stones alone informed the Acora table's cast-bronze base, with its top of rift-sawn oak.
